

Bluer skies are in sight for Ateneo with new eJEEPs powered by Meralco and its subsidiary MServ - Ateneo de Manila (ADMU) upgrades its campus shuttle system with the spruced-up and eco-friendlier Ateneo eJEEPs, which boasts of 30% improved efficiency compared to a regular jeepney. A regular passenger jeepney consumes Php6.70 per kilometer but an eJEEP only consumes Php4.70 per kilometer. Ateneo students, employees and faculty are free to board and shuttle their way among the buildings within the sprawling campus. Aside from reducing campus carbon emission, the eJEEP shuttle system is also a solution towards a less-congested traffic situation in the university. Ateneo's eJEEP is the groundbreaking e-Vehicle (EV) initiative actualized via Ateneo's partnership with Meralco and MServ-Meralco's wholly-owned subsidiary which provides energy-related services and solutions.
